## FLAG SIZES FOR GROUND MOUNTED FLAGPOLES

Recommended flag length is between $1 / 4$ and $1 / 3$ the height of your flagpole.

## FLAG SIZES FOR RESIDENTIAL HOUSE MOUNTED FLAGPOLES

Flag poles are typically 5 ft . or 6 ft ., suitable for a $21 / 2 \times 4 \mathrm{ft}$. banner or $3 \times 5 \mathrm{ft}$. flag.
Tangle free rotating flagpoles are best suited to keep the flag from wrapping around the pole.
Flagpole brackets are available in cast aluminum, adjustable aluminum and polished brass.
